Although the abovementioned is the current level of turnover and is closely related to economic indicators, it may be more or less in future. Consequently, this Certificate does not serve as a guarantee that the income reflected will continue at the same levels. Where the entity is a start-up enterprise this EME Certificate is valid only for the contracts with a single value of less than or equal to R 5 Million. Should the contract value being tendered for be higher than R 5 Million, and less than R35 million, the EME will be required to submit a QSE Verification Certificate with any tender. For contracts over R35 million a B-BBEE Verification Certificate based on the Generic Codes must be submitted.
